Important Information for Teams

Teams must supply all equipment, grills, utensils, etc.

Teams will supply all food to be sampled and judged.

We expect upwards of 300 people, so we recommend you prepare 300 or so small, appetizer portions. A small portion might include one rib, one wing, one ounce of beef, two shrimp, etc.

Grill teams may get sponsors to pay for their expenses.

The event will supply paper plates, forks, and napkins. If you would like to serve in something else, please bring it.

Grill teams are encouraged to wear costumes and decorate their grill areas related to their names/themes.

Grill teams need to bring their own “coffee can” to capture money donations. Whoever accumulates the most money in their coffee can is given the bragging rights for Best Griller of the Year. All coffee can monies are then donated to the museum for the fundraiser.

Beer, pop, and water will be sold by an official vendor (i.e. Golf Course) at the site. Teams are not allowed to bring their own alcoholic beverages.
